Rules and Regulations

You must...

- Provide proof of your identity (e.g. national identity card or passport) at registration and every examination session.
 Second country nationals must produce a passport. This ID must contain a number, a signature, a date of birth and a photograph.
- Provide two recent passport-sized photographs on registration.
- Only have on your desk a pen/pencil and an eraser.
- Ensure mobile phones and pagers are switched off and placed with personal belongings in the area designated by the supervisor. Any candidate who does not switch off their phone/ pager, or who retains one in their possession, will be disqualified.
- Notify the test invigilator immediately if test day conditions in any way impede your performance.

You must not...

- Attempt to cheat, copy the work of another candidate or disrupt the test.
